As of February 12, student organizations may host in-person events, gatherings, and tabling activities of 10 or fewer people

Permission applies on- and off-campus

On-campus reservations: risk mitigation plan, advisor approval, no food

University funds cannot be used on travel through at least 6/30/21



## **The Latest Updates**

As of May 10, university organizations may host in-person events

Must follow state, local, and university guidelines

Group sizes will be limited based on the capacity of the location

Events must be approved in advance

Need clarity re: how this applies to student organizations

## What Is Organization Sustainability?



Sustainable student organizations...

- Have a clear focus on their purpose
- Bring in at least as many new members as they lose
- Have a pipeline of members for leadership roles, and effective leadership transitions
- Are financially self-sustaining
- Innovate and adapt to changing environments
- Foster inclusion, equity, and belonging
- Are connected to the student organization and university community
- What else?



## **Making Sense of the Past Year**



What will you continue, (re-)start, stop doing?

Acknowledge emotions, motivation, and burnout

Celebrate and recognize individual and collective efforts (positional leaders, graduating students, those who stepped up)



#### Who's With Us?

**20% Always Joiners** 

60% Maybe Joiners

**20% Never Joiners** 

"Maybe Joiners" are where we typically focus our outreach efforts

"Always Joiners" are the people we probably saw/ who probably joined our organizations this year

# **Making Plans for Next Year**


How will you (re-)orient your newest members?
