**Description of Organization:** After-School All-Stars Ohio is a chapter of the leading national organization that provides year-round, school-based, comprehensive after-school programs that include academics, enrichment activities, and health and fitness for elementary and middle school aged students. We serve nearly 800 students in ten schools located across the state in three cities (Cleveland, Columbus, and Toledo). The students we serve are from low-income families, over 95% of them qualify for free or reduced lunch, and they are classified as underserved minority students with significant opportunity gaps and live in impoverished communities. ASAS Ohio positively impacts the students, the working families, and the communities it serves by providing a positive and healthy after-school program for at-risk youth that may be struggling to reach their true potential.
