Article IV - There are four defined officer positions with committee officers positions being added as necessary. The offices are the offices of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The president is responsible for leading the organization, organizing meetings, programs, and workshops. The vice-president is responsible for assisting the president with the president's duties. The treasurer is responsible for keeping track of the organization's funds. The secretary is responsible for taking minutes if needed and distributing information about meetings, programs, and workshops. The term of office for all offices is one year. An officer must be currently enrolled.

Article V - There are no dues. Robert's Rules of Order are used for voting. It takes a majority vote to ratify an issue and a 2/3rds vote to dismiss a previously ratified issue.
