

Purpose statement

Taiwanese Undergraduate Networking Association is founded to facilitate networking among Taiwanese undergraduate students as well as international students from other countries, and promote Taiwanese cultures, languages, and foodways.

Member selection and removal criteria

All of the students in the Ohio State University are welcome to join Taiwanese Student Networking Association. Members who are not respectful toward people based on their color, disability, gender identity or expression, genetic information, HIV/AIDS status, race, sex, etc., will be removed of the membership.

Officer positions and duties

Terms of Office for all officers are a whole academic year (Autumn 2021-Summer 2022) and the election process will start toward the end of Summer 2022.

Primary Leader

- Hold monthly meetings
- Facilitate networking opportunities among members
- Answer questions and proactively take care of all officials and members

Secondary Leader

- Assist the primary leader and other officials
- Take attendance during meetings and events
- Substitute the primary leader when they are absent

Treasurer

- Manage funds and the bank account
- Manage dues of events

Advisor

- Work with the primary leaders to facilitate networking opportunities for members

Social Media Chair

- Manage social media accounts, including private Facebook group and public Instagram account
- Take pictures during events and post afterwards

Event Chairperson

- Brainstorm new events based on members' needs
- Debrief with the primary and secondary leaders to improve the events afterwards

Secretary

- Take minutes for meetings and take pictures for events
- Work with the event chairperson to meet members' needs during events

Officer selection and removal criteria

Officer selection process will start toward the end of Summer 2023. The nomination will be held in the beginning of July online through google form and the official election will be two weeks after the nomination.

All nominees should come up with at least 1 goal for the position and 1 event in Taiwanese Undergraduate Networking Association for the upcoming semester. The official election will also be online through anonymous google form. Results will be declared at the end of July and the transition process will be facilitated by the two primary leaders.

Officers who refused to fulfill their duties and who disrespect other members/officers based on their age, gender identity and expression, sex, majors, national origins, etc., will be removed from the organization.
