

As the Women's Fútbol Club at Ohio State, we as an association want to promote a healthy and active lifestyle through the recreation of soccer. Our intention is to promote an inclusive environment for Ohio State students who want to play soccer, and support organizations who serve underprivileged communities. To create inclusive and competitive play, board members will hold annual tryouts in the fall semester and semi-annual tryouts in the spring semester. As board members select players for our club we will look for hardworking individuals who not only love the sport of soccer, but enjoy volunteering, social events, and being a part of a team. We as a club expect respectful and fun individuals who will positively promote and represent our club. Members will be expected to pay a fee of \$75 to join the club in order to cover indoor facility fees. Members will also be expected to participate in at least five hours of community events with the team. This could include donating time to any service event, hosting an event, or helping with the planning of events. If any member fails to pay their dues, meet community service requirements, or breach any rule of inclusion, they will be asked to leave the club without receiving a refund. They will be reported to the club advisor, and if needed reported to the university. Board elections will be held each annual term or fall semester. Board selection will be a vote amongst previous board members and players. Whichever members receive the most votes for each position, will be cast the title of either, treasurer, or advisor. The President and Vice-president will not change terms unless a breach in contract followed with a separate election. No member can hold more than one position at a time. If any board member fails to follow the constitution or diversity and inclusion statement, they will be asked to remove themselves from their executive position and from the club completely. If any member fails to

comply they will be reported to the club advisor and the university if needed. This contract is subject to change at any time.

Our goal as an organization is to create a positive environment for good soccer players to broadcast their skills while also improving the community of Columbus and communities across the map. We as a club have a starting goal of 40 club members, which will section off into four teams of ten. Teams will switch opponents every week in order to create friendly competition and fair play. Our community service goals include serving underprivileged sports programs in our own community and beyond. We plan to pair with local companies to sponsor trips across the world to serve communities without proper sports equipment and resources. Our service goals as an organization are to create a comfortable and fair sports environment for players across city, state, and regional lines.
