Rock City On Campus Revised November 2023

Article | Name

Section One: The name of this organization shall be "Rock City On Campus."

Article II Purpose & Goals

Section One: Rock City On Campus at The Ohio State University provides opportunities for students to gather, learn and grow together on campus, equipping them to become fully devoted followers of Jesus while in school and upon graduation.

Section Two: Rock City On Campus abides by and supports established Ohio State University policies, State and Federal Laws.

Article III Membership

Attendees

All persons may attend the meetings, events and other activities of Rock City On Campus. We welcome all people to come and hear the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and to be in community with us. However, attendees have no power to determine policy for Rock City On Campus, nor can they formally represent or act on its behalf. Furthermore, we reserve the right to conduct all meetings, small groups, retreats, and events in a manner that is in accordance with our Constitution and moral convictions based on Scripture.

Members

Membership is open to all students at Ohio State who support the purposes of the organization.

Revocation of Membership

Any individual's membership, including the leadership of any Officer and/or Advisor, may be revoked for actions contrary to the purposes of the organization or that harm the effectiveness of the organization. In the event of a disagreement over whether an individual's membership may be revoked, the final decision will be made by the Advisor.

Article IV Officers

Officer Requirements

Officers should have demonstrated a commitment to the purposes of the organization. In addition they must

a. Have a minimum cumulative grade point ratio (GPA) as stated below and meet that minimum GPA in the semester immediately prior to the election/appointment, the semester of election/appointment and semesters during the term of office. For undergraduate students, the minimum cumulative GPA is 2.00. In order for this provision to be met, at least six hours (half-time credits) must have been taken for the semester under consideration.

b. Be in good standing with the university and enrolled: at least half time (six or more credit hours), if an undergraduate student (unless fewer credits are required to graduate in the spring and fall semesters) during the term of office, and at least half time (four or more credits), if a graduate level student (unless fewer credits are required in the final stages of their degree as defined by the Continuous Registration Requirement) during their term of office.

c. Be ineligible to hold an office should the student fail to maintain the requirements as prescribed in (a) and (b).

Officers

The Officers of Rock City On Campus shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Social Chair, Recruitment Chair, Event Coordinator, Outreach Coordinator, Worship Coordinator, and Faculty Advisor.

- Recruitment Chair
 - Creates recruitment events
 - Works with Event Coordinator to plan and execute recruitment events
 - Head of organizing Student Involvement Fair table and ideas to help recruitment of new members
 - Communicates to Executive Team their role in recruitment purposes
 - Ideas and working on ways to increase numbers of people at events
- Event Coordinator
 - Organizes and plans semester events
 - Creates semester calendar for team to utilize
 - Reserves rooms, oval spaces and parking/tailgating spaces
- Outreach Coordinator
 - Sources opportunities to have events with external organizations including the Columbus Dream Center
- Worship Coordinator
 - Organizes worship team and recruits new members
 - Finds ways to stay organized within worship team
- Advisor
 - Ensure that organization is operating under the requirements set by Ohio State University and the Student Activities Council
 - Communicate with President any issues or requests of the organization

Advisor Appointment

The Advisor must be a faculty or staff member who has demonstrated a commitment to the organization's goals and has the support of the Executive Committee.

Officer/Advisor Removal

Officers and/or Advisors may be removed from their positions by a majority vote held by the rest of the Executive Committee and a final vote made by the Advisor if they fail to abide by the requirements listed above. The Officer is allowed to speak to the Executive Committee about the charges made concerning his/her conduct. The Officer is not given leave to participate during the final deliberation of the Executive Committee regarding the individual's membership status.

Article V. Finances

Organization Monies

Rock City On Campus shall have a budget consisting of money from Rock City Church. If the organization is dissolved, then all monies shall be given to Rock City Church. There will be no dues collected.

All monies belonging to Rock City On Campus shall be deposited and disbursed through a bank account established for this organization at Huntington Bank. All funds deposited to Huntington Bank must be deposited within 24 hours after collection. The Rock City Church representative to this organization must approve and sign each expenditure completed through Huntington Bank.

Article VI. Amendments & Ratification

Amendments

Proposed amendments to this constitution must be submitted in writing and approved by a 2/3 vote of Officers and affirmed by the Advisor.

Ratification

This constitution will be provisionally active upon affirmation by the President and the Advisor, and will go fully into effect when ratified by 2/3 of the Officers. If it is not approved by the end of the term, a new constitution will be drafted.

Article VII. Non-Discrimination Clause

Rock City On Campus will not discriminate in the acceptance of members, rank, or office on the basis of age, ancestry, color, disability, gender identity or expression, genetic information, HIV/AIDS status, military status, national origin, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, protected veteran status or any other basis in accordance with Student Organization Registration and Funding Guidelines.
