Expectations

 - Including strategic planning, program development, and problem-solving

 - This includes gathering and buying supplies
 - Creating menu/communicating it with Sarah
 - Setting up/cleaning up event
 - Enthusiastically promoting event in a manner of your choosing
 - I.e. Speaking about it on Shabbat, texting students, sending JOSU messages frequently, posting on social media

 - Runs the Chabad House at OSU
 - Approves events
 - Manages funds and ordering event supplies
 - Offers guidance and support in event planning
- Freshman Engagement Coordinator Goldie Davidson
 - o Creates, plans, and runs freshman and dorm related events
 - Assists board members where help is needed
- Senior Advisor Gilad Krasner-Cohen
 - Offers expertise and guidance to board members
 - Assists Graduate Chair in event planning
 - Participate in alumni relationships

Special Programming

- Jewish Buckeyes in Business
 - Unite Jewish students in business
 - Create networking opportunities
 - Improve business related skills, i.e. resume and communication workshops
- Ambassadors for Judaism at OSU
 - Bridge to leadership for underclassmen
 - Promote Chabad related events
 - Assists board members where help is needed
- Antisemitism Committee at OSU
 - Meets monthly with OSU admin
 - Advocates for removal of hate speech, symbols, and groups
 - Promotes a positive, safe, inclusive environment for Jewish students

Constitution

- Membership criteria/selection
 - Membership is free and open to all Jewish students or students who want to learn more about or experience Judaism; undergraduate and graduate students.
- Member removal criteria and process
 - Criteria for removal for members includes if members make other members feel unsafe.
 - They will be asked to leave the premises from advisors.
- Officer selection
 - Officers will be selected from advisors and past board members after completing application.
- Officer removal criteria and process
 - Officers who do not follow constitution and guidelines fit criteria for removal.
 - President and advisors will meet to discuss removal, address the issue with the officer, and then remove the officer if deemed appropriate.
